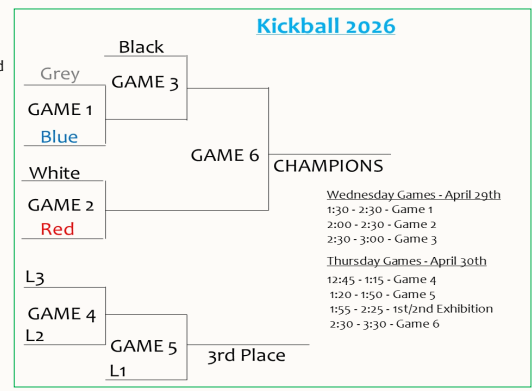
## MAP Testing
