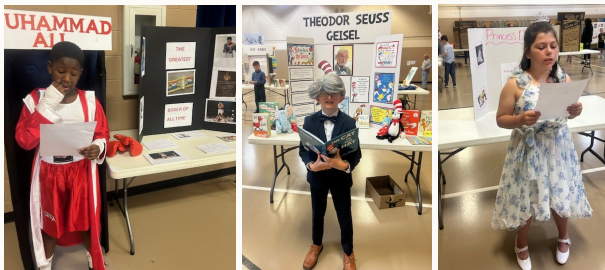
# Classroom News.....

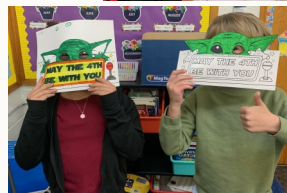
